According to our working principles:

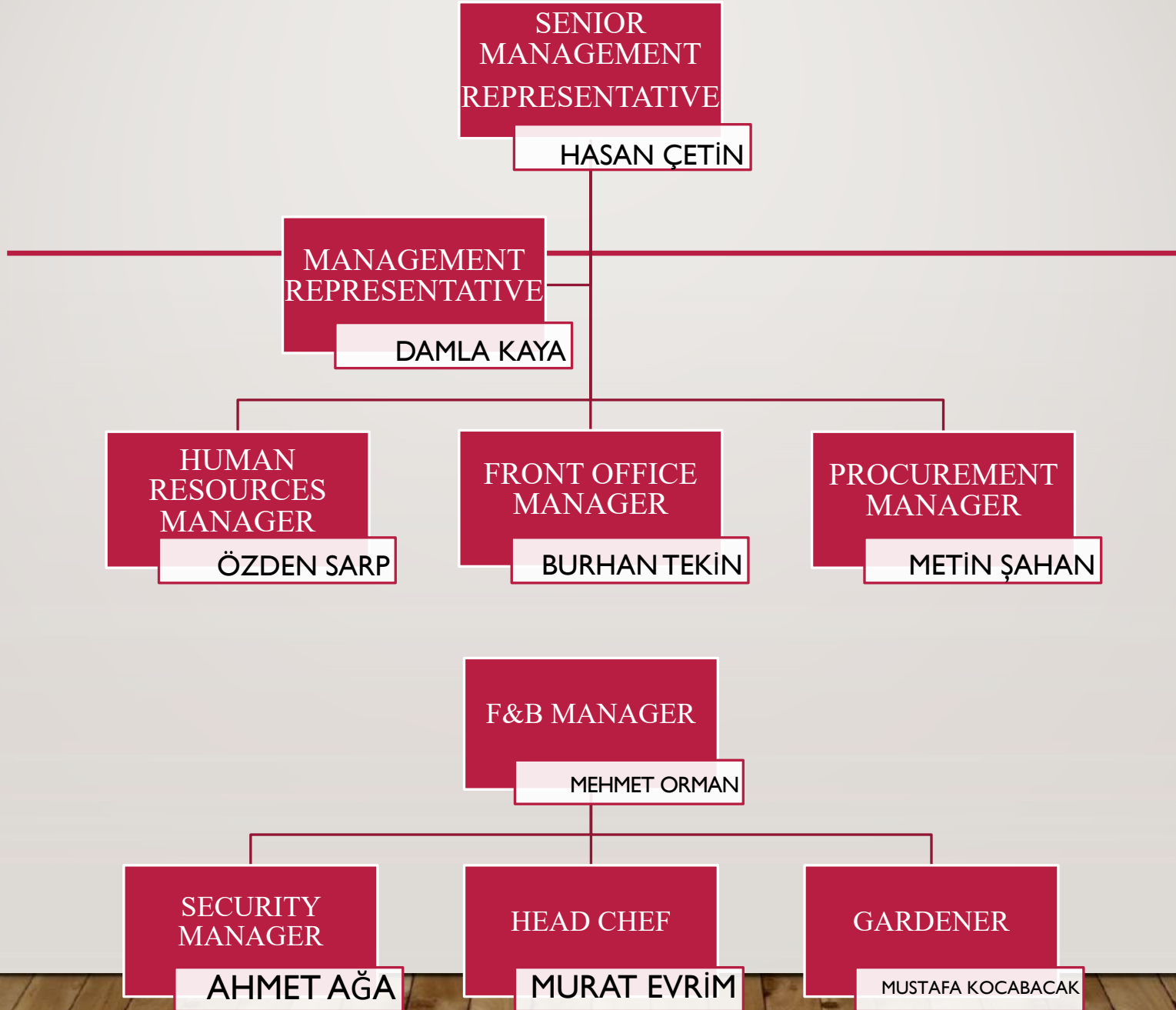
- The health and well-being of children is of the highest importance.

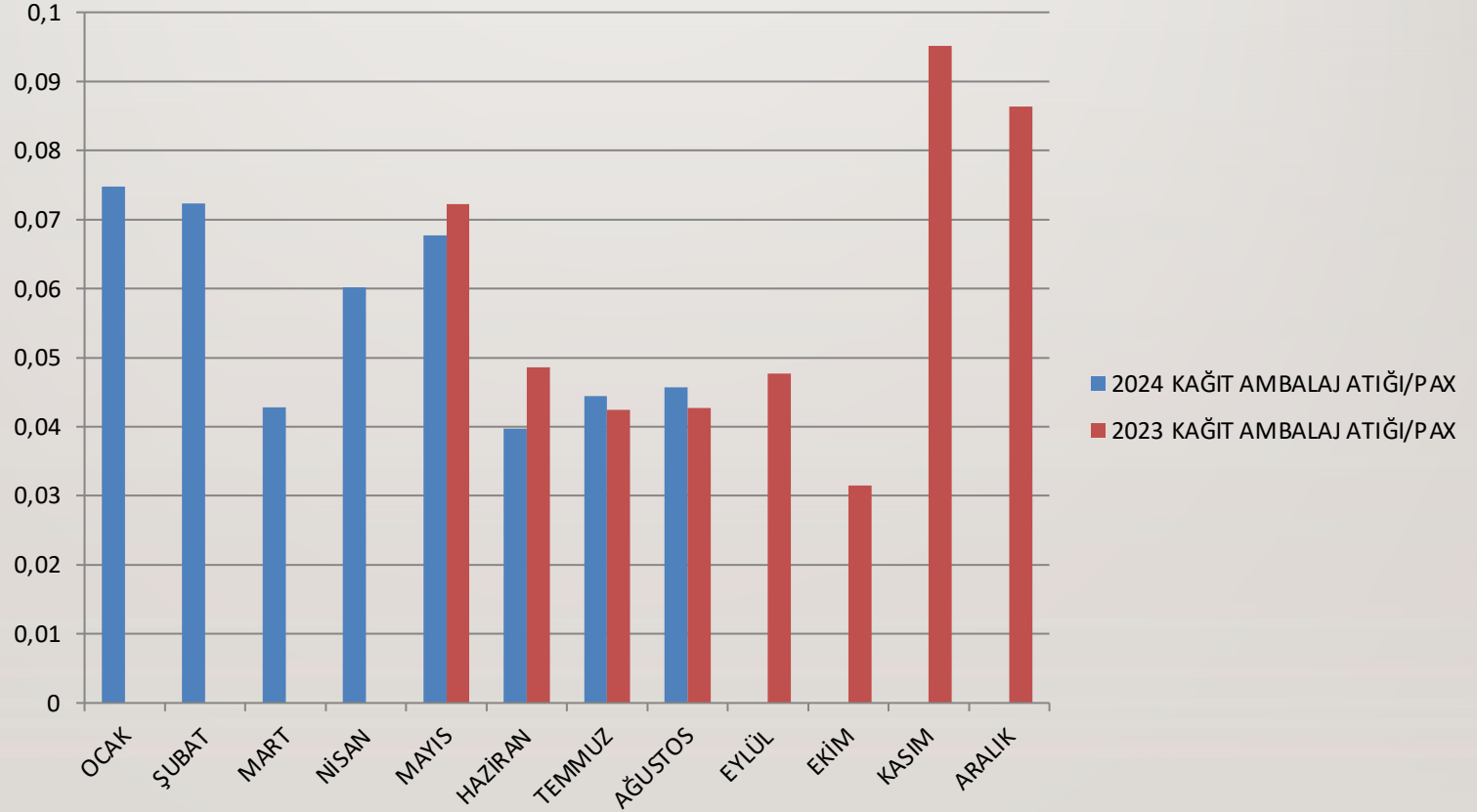

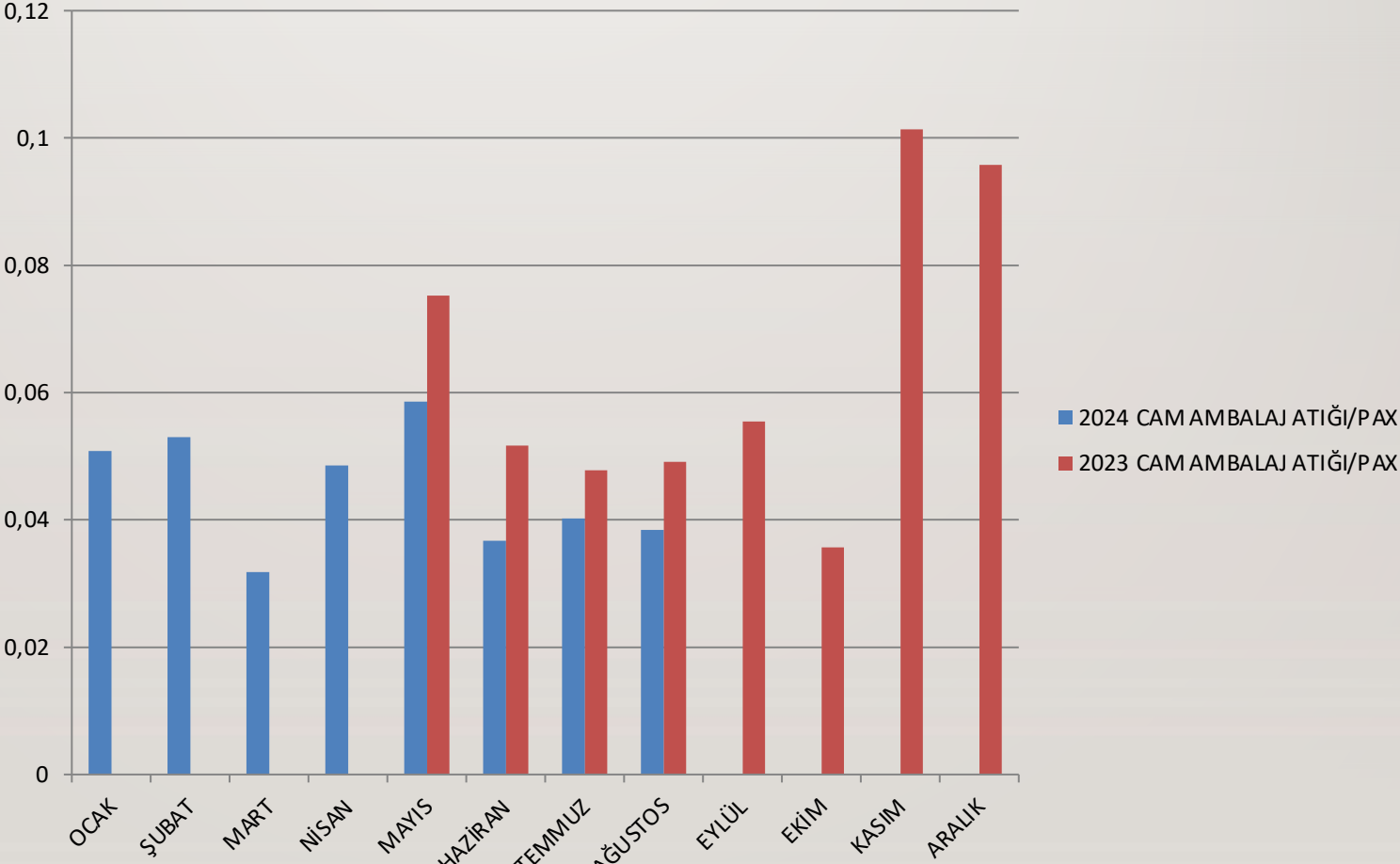

PAPER PACKAGING WASTE COMPARISON BY MONTH



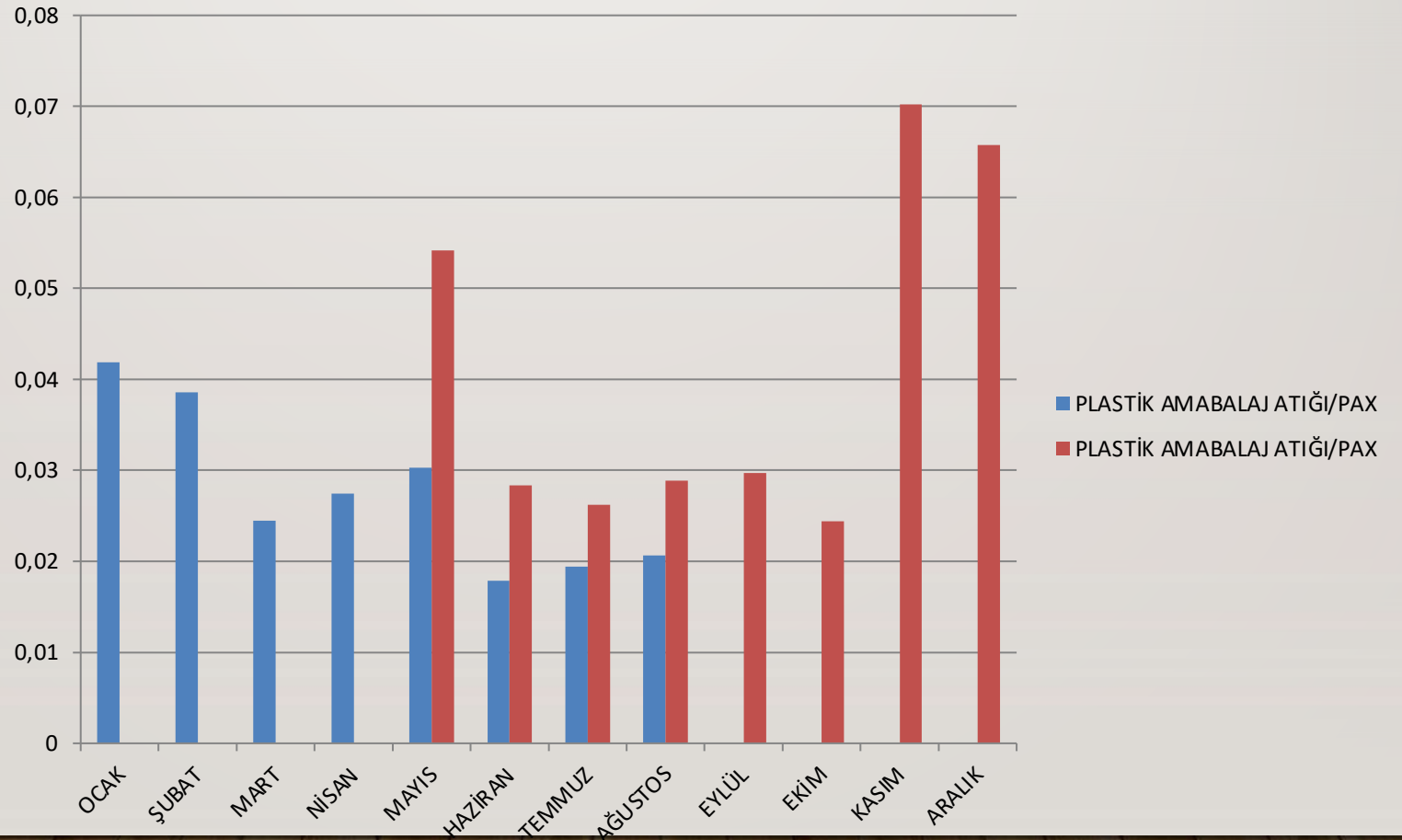

GLASS PACKAGING WASTE COMPARISON BY MONTH



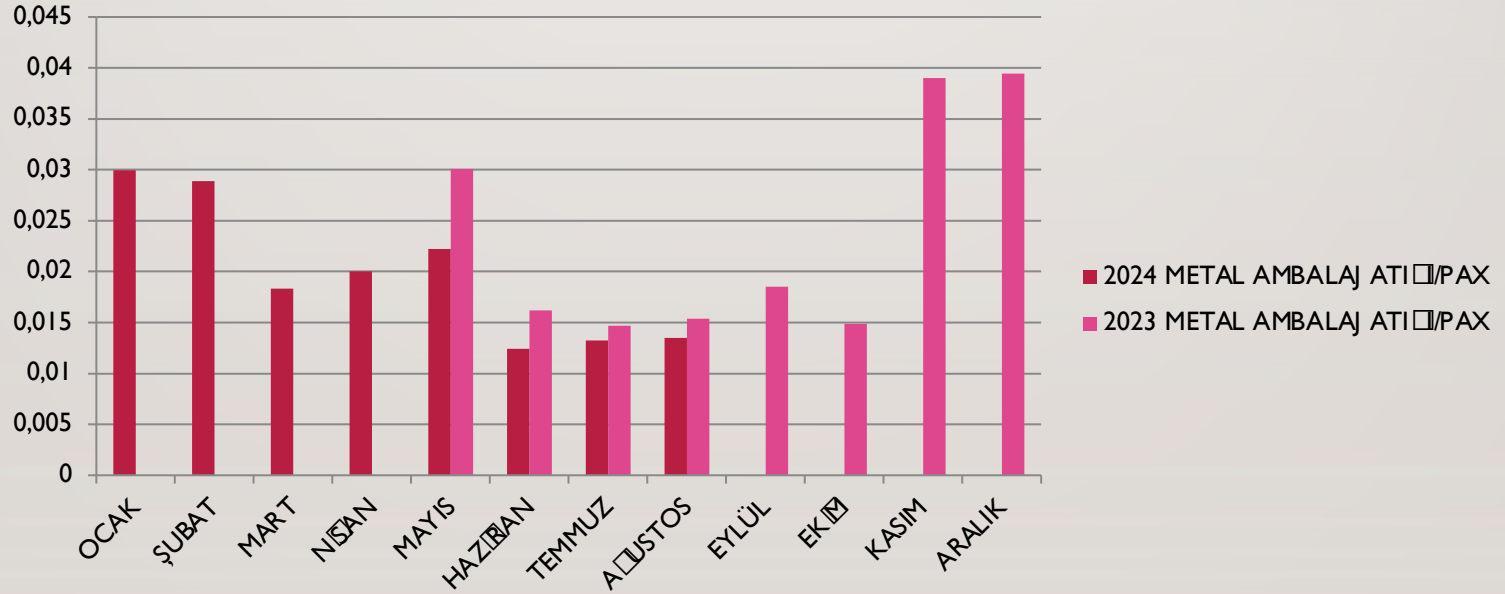

PLASTIC PACKAGING WASTE COMPARISON BY MONTH



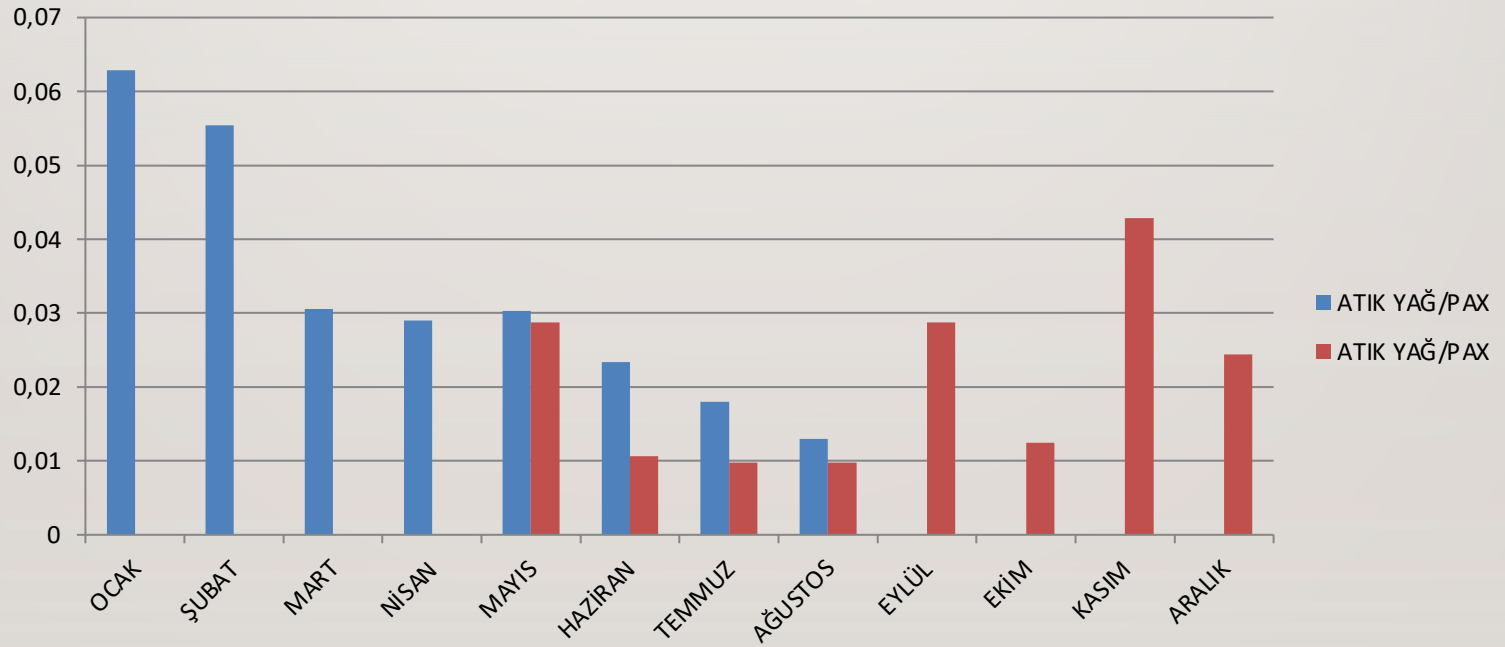

WASTE OIL COMPARISON BY MONTH

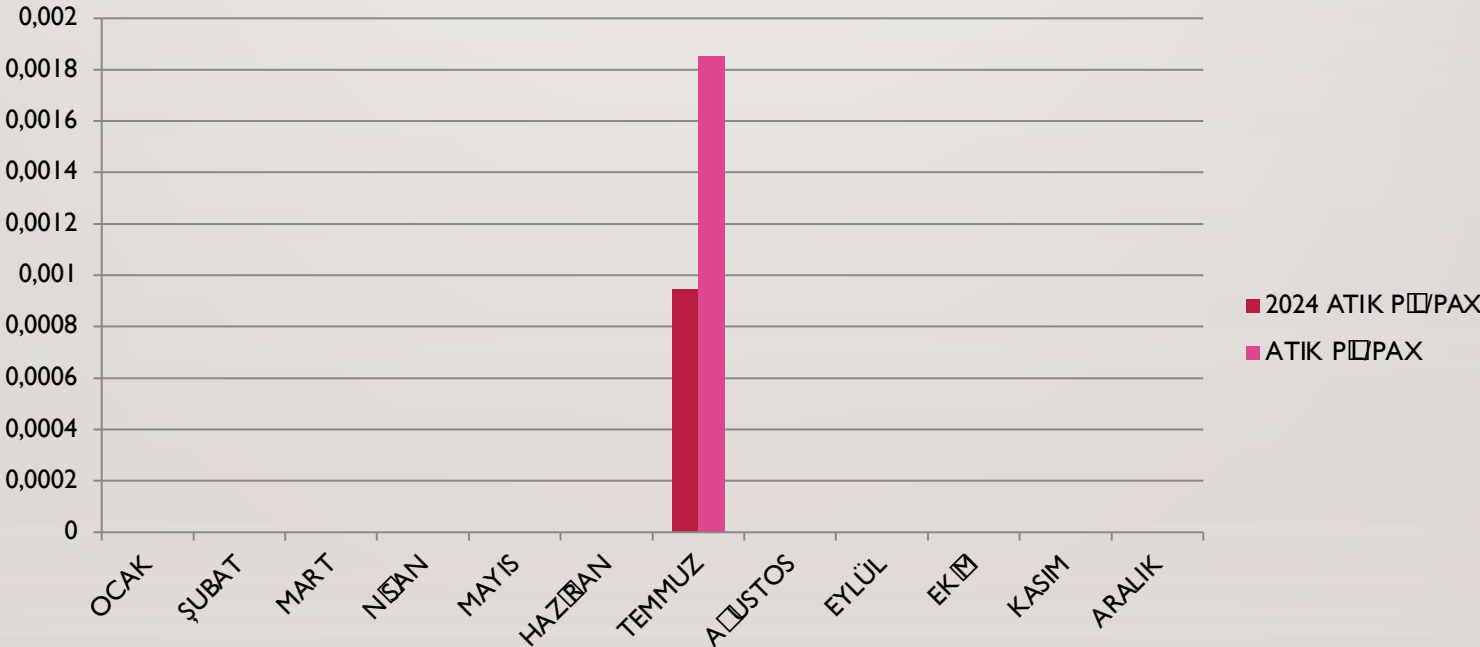


NON-RECYCLABLE WASTE

- In 2023, the hazardous wastes shown in the table were received and disposed of by licensed recycling companies from our facility.

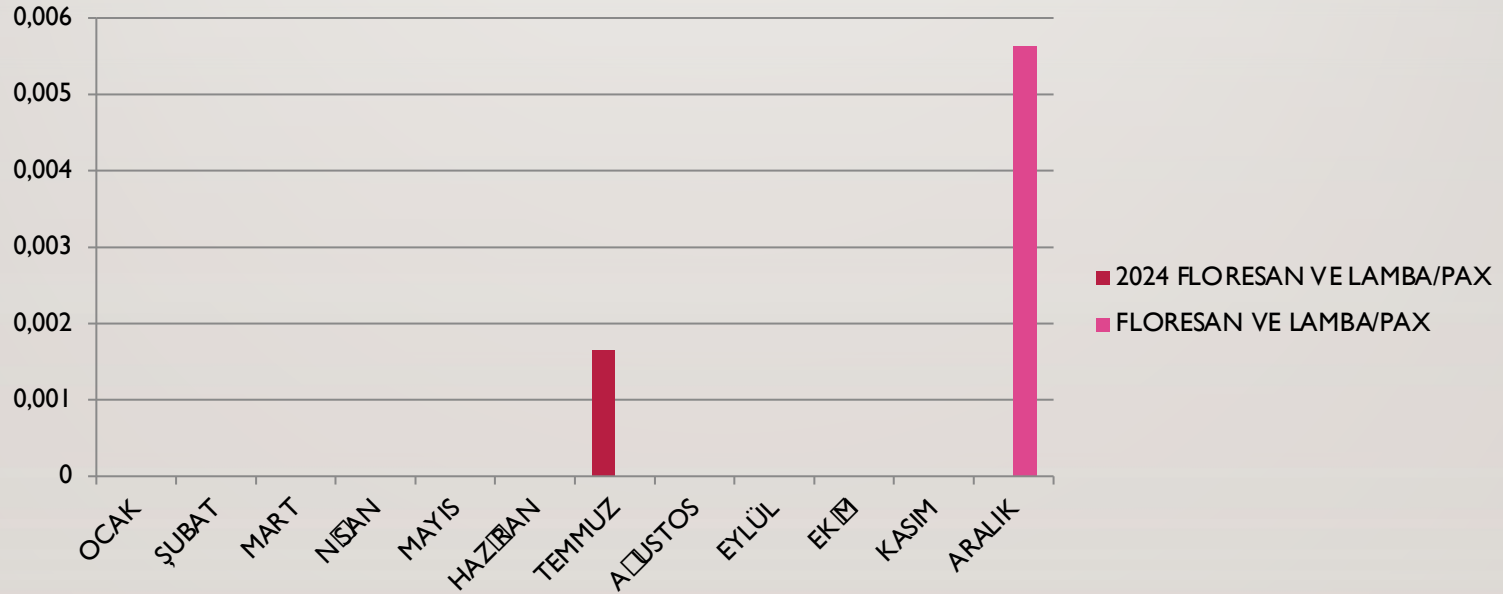

WASTE BATTERY COMPARISON BY MONTH



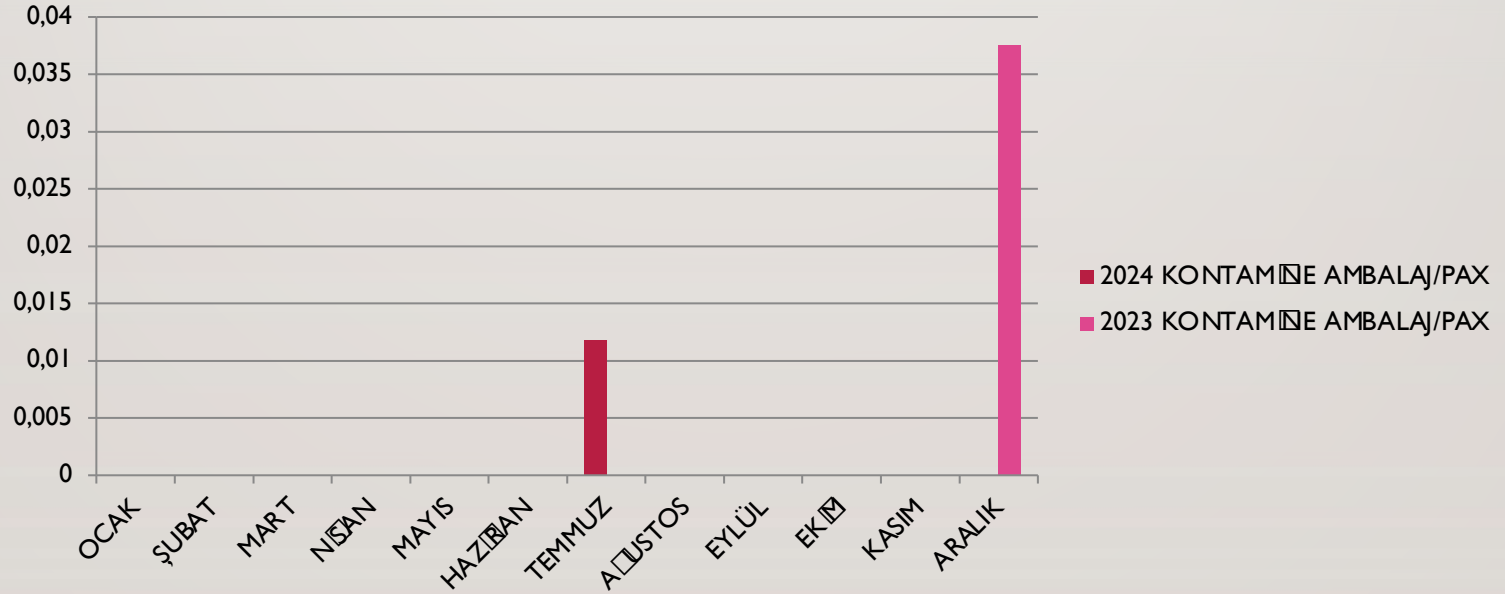
FLUORESCENT LAMPS AND OTHER MERCURY WASTES

COMPARISON OF FLUORESCENT AND LAMP BY MONTH



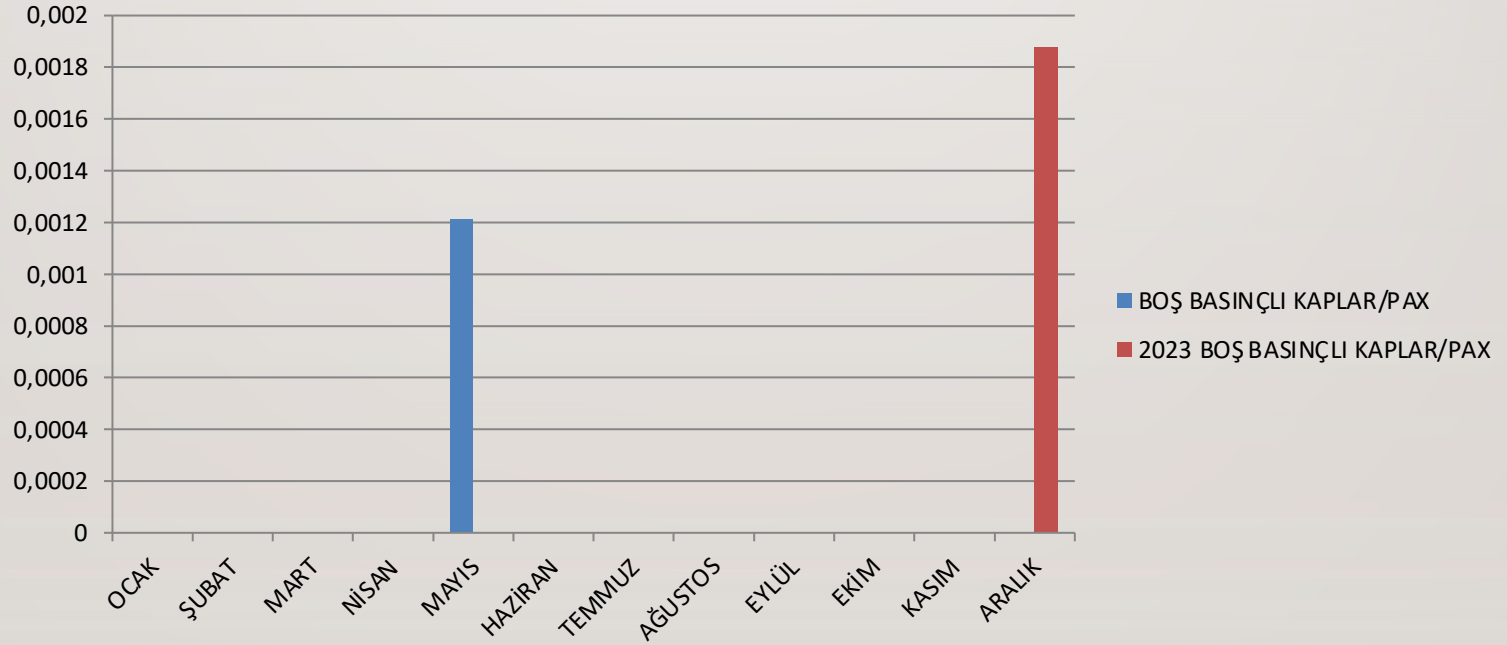

CONTAMINATED PACKAGING COMPARISON BY MONTH



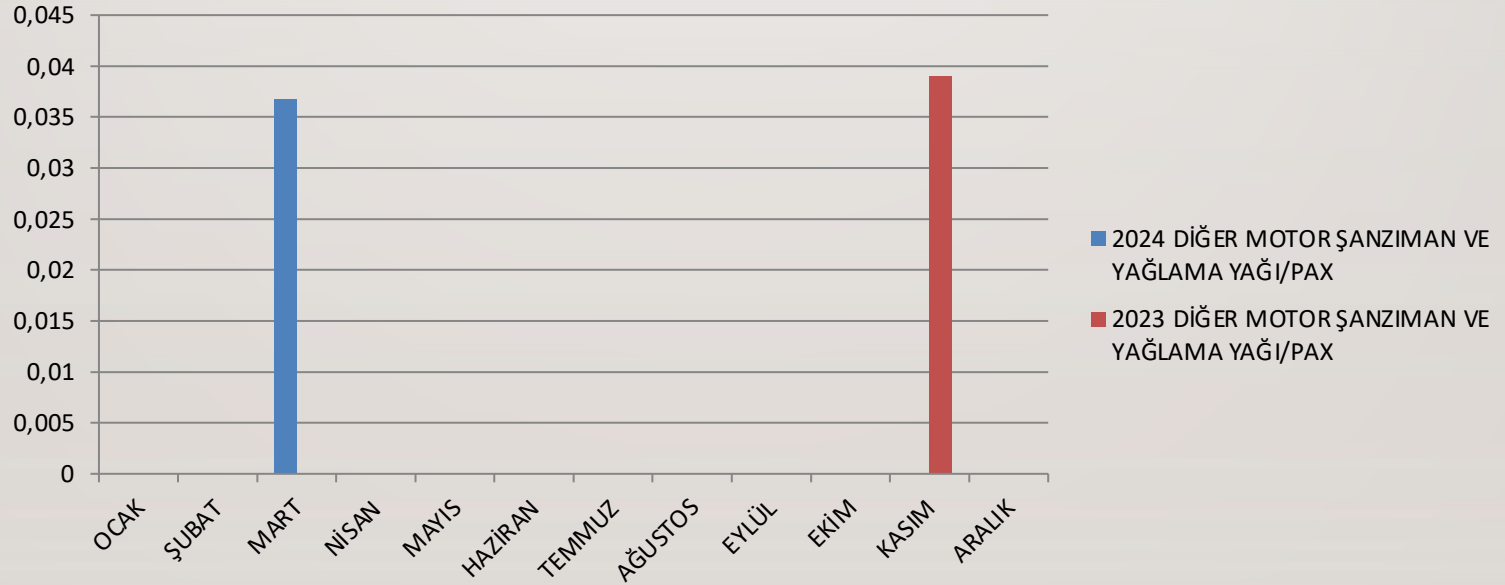

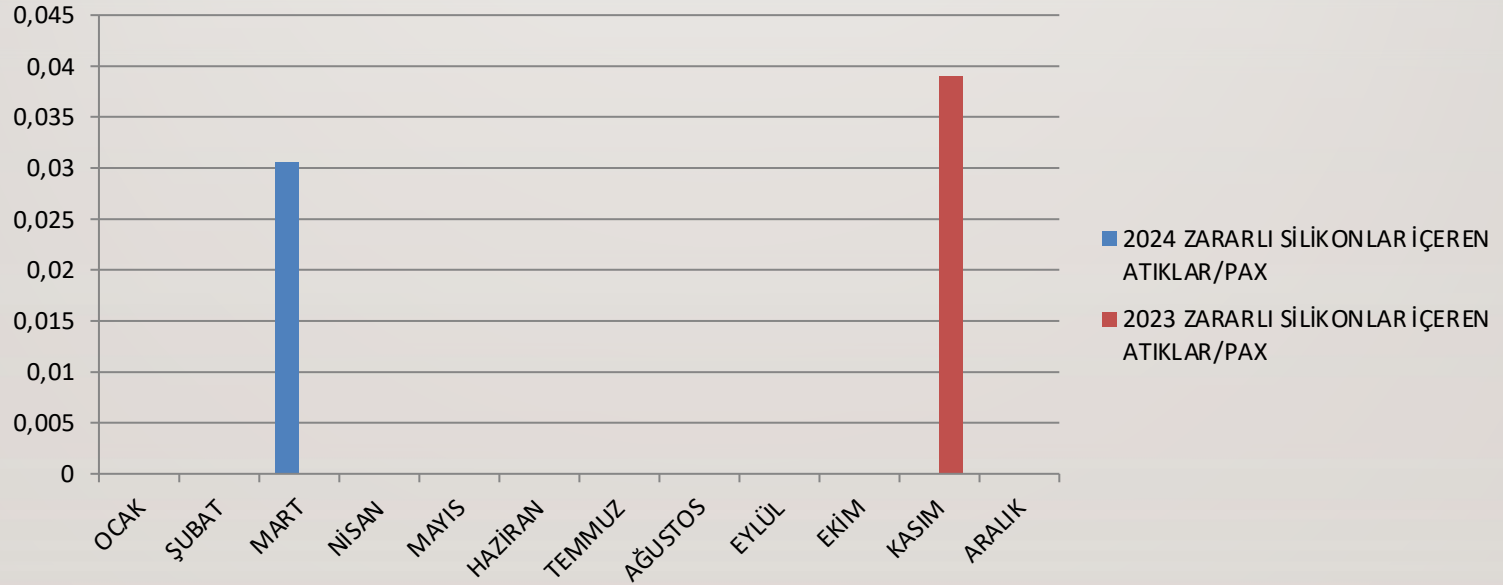
OTHER ENGINE TRANSMISSION AND LUBRICATING OILS

COMPARISON OF OTHER ENGINE TRANSMISSION AND LUBRICATING OILS WASTES BY MONTHS



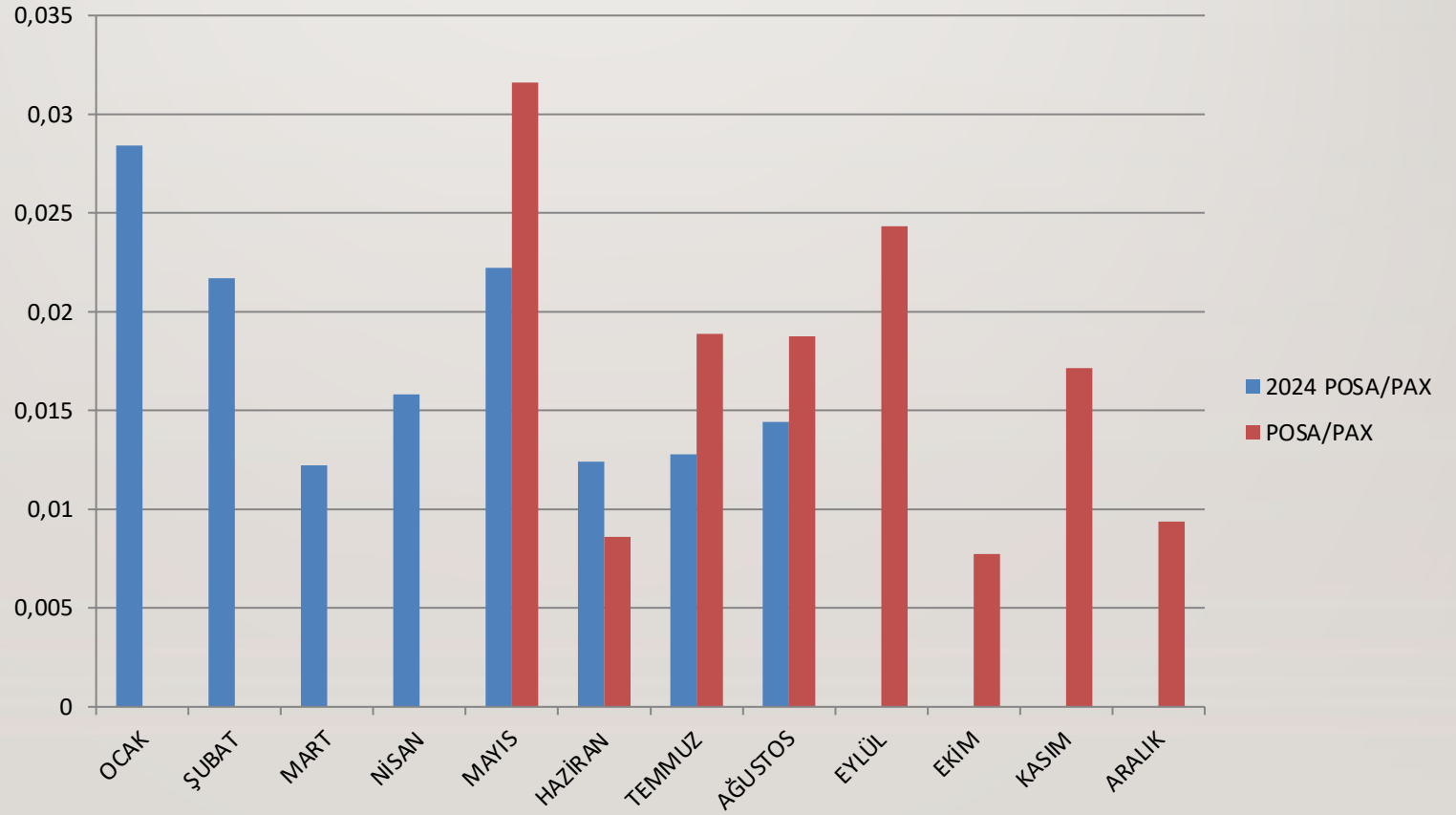
WASTE CONTAINING HARMFUL SILICONES

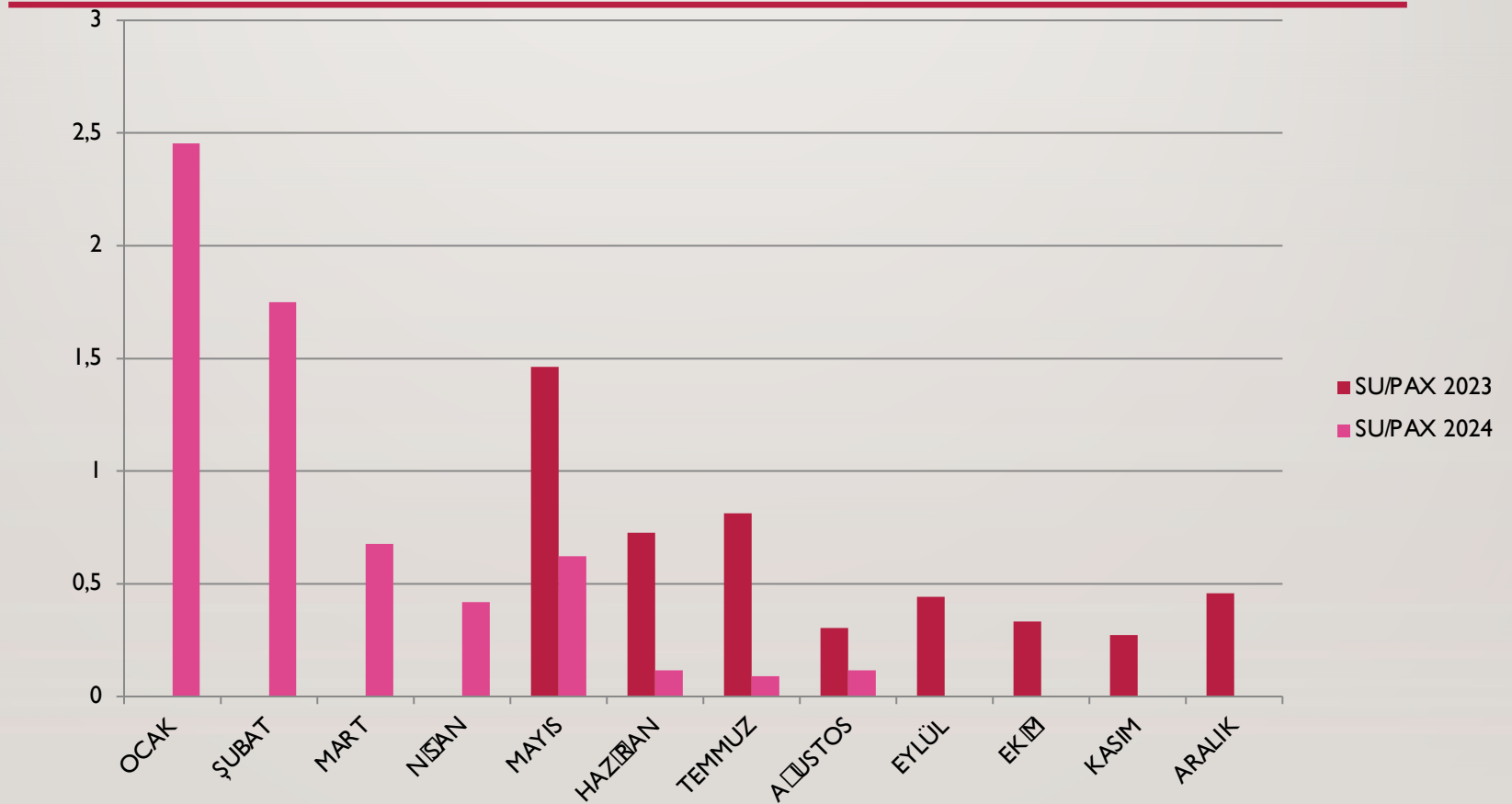


RESOURCE MANAGEMENT WATER CONSUMPTION

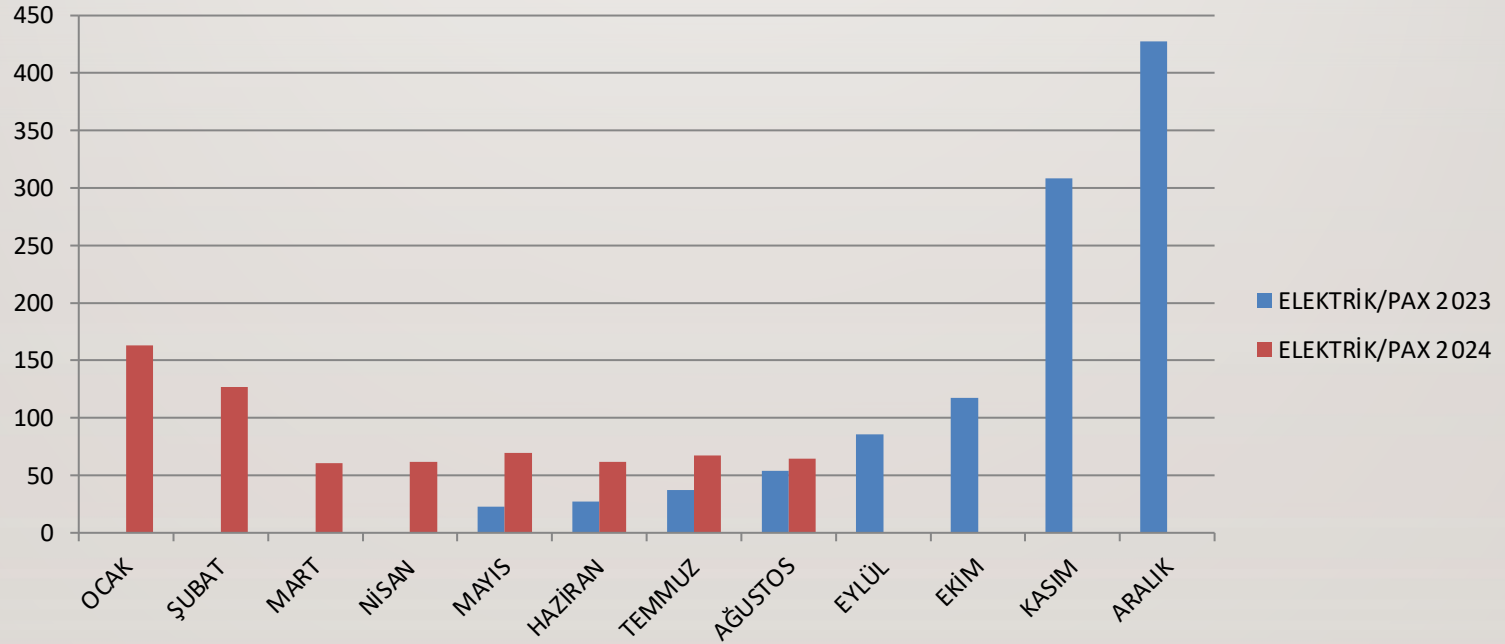
WATER CONSUMPTION

WATER CONSUMPTION MONTHLY COMPARISON



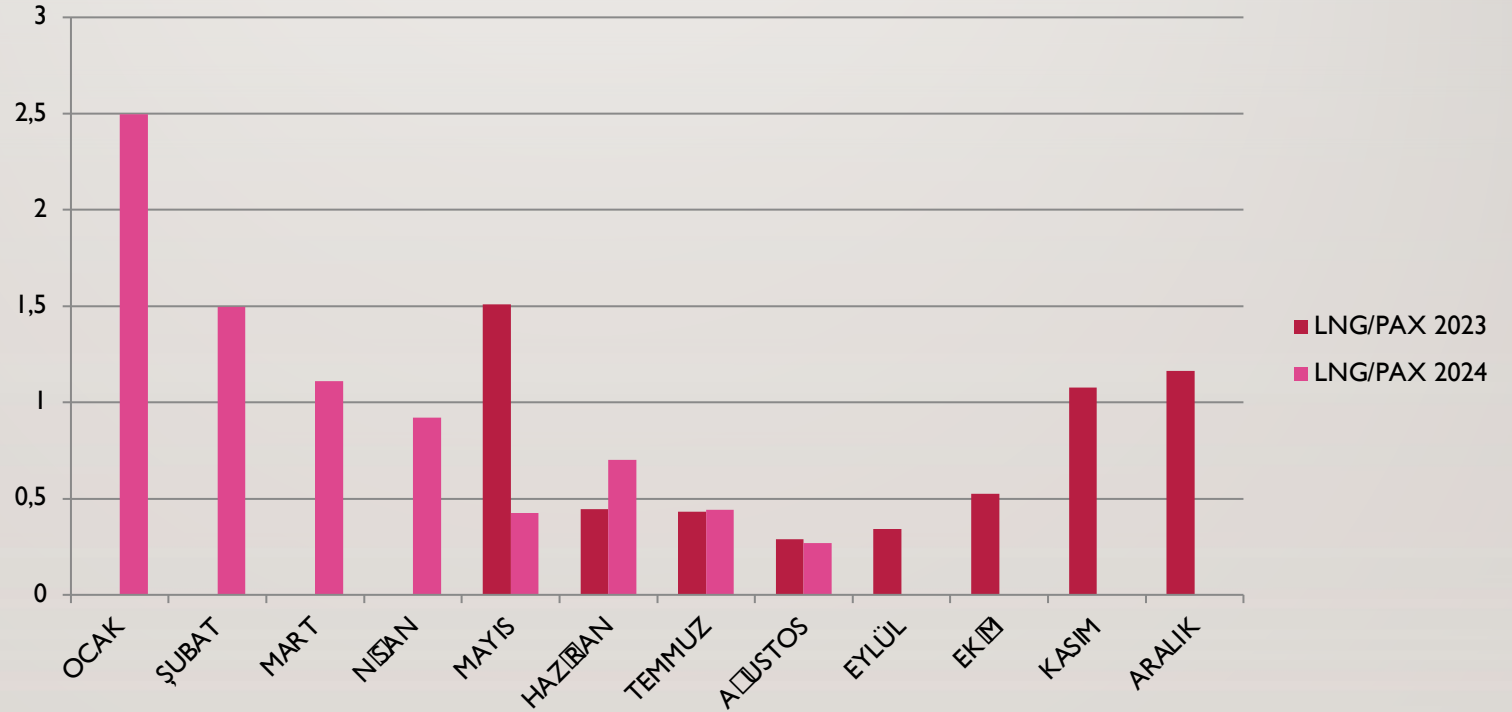
ELECTRICITY CONSUMPTION

ELECTRICITY CONSUMPTION MONTHLY COMPARISON



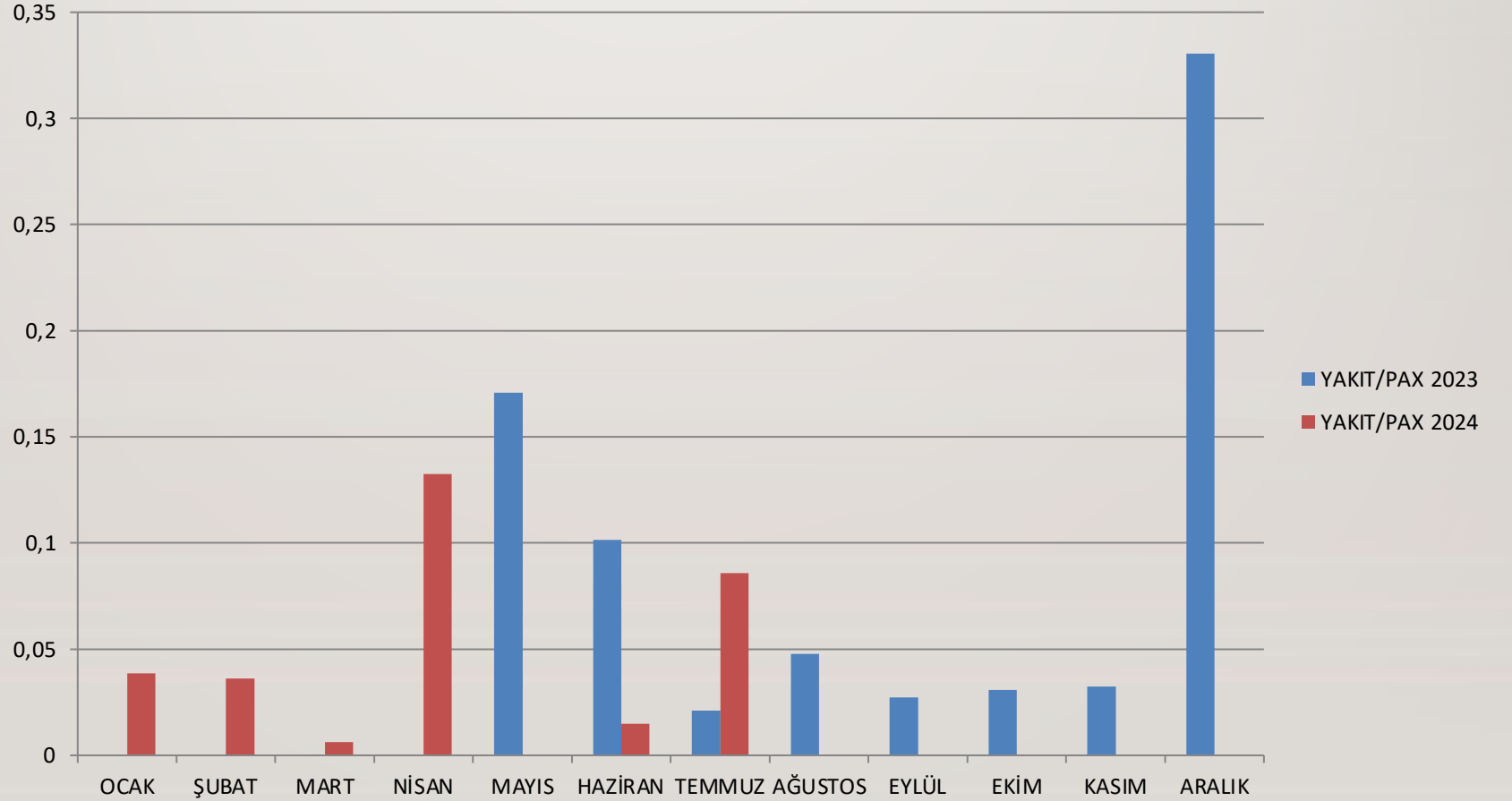
LNG CONSUMPTION

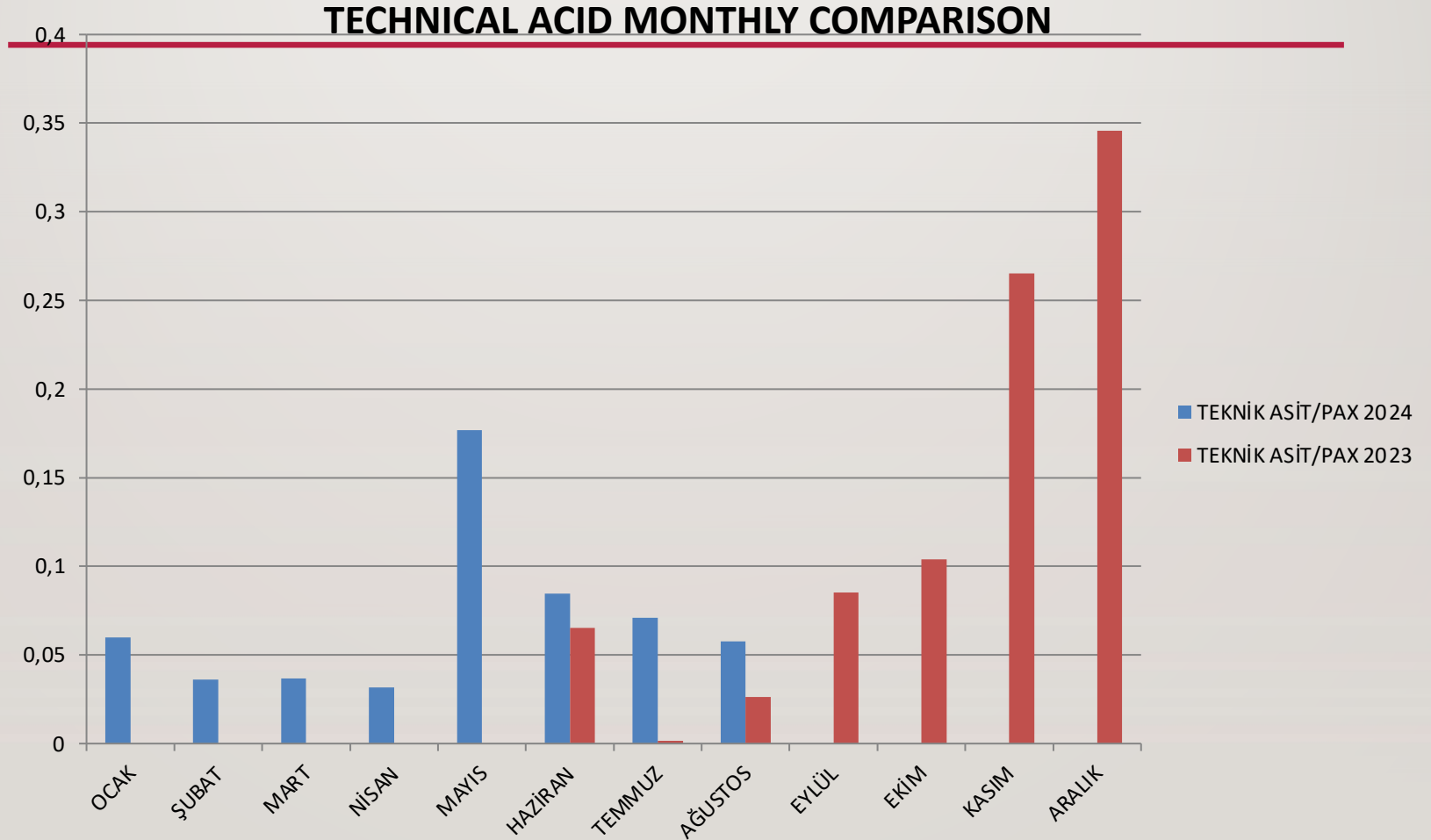
USE OF CHEMICAL CONSUMPTION

We take the necessary precautions for hazardous chemical waste, leaks, etc., and provide personnel training for response to spills, exposures and other incidents.

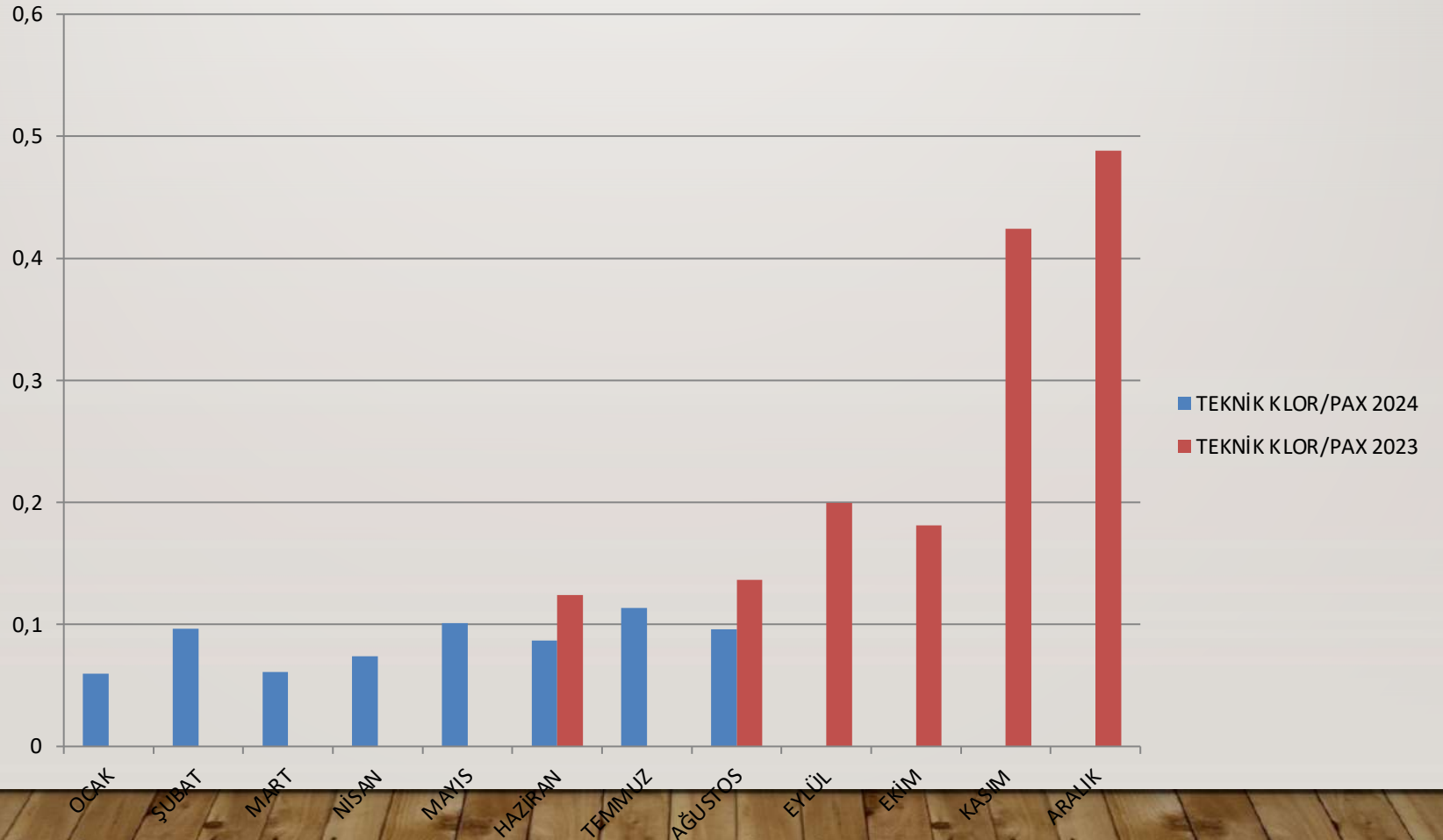


TECHNICAL SERVICE ACID CONSUMPTION



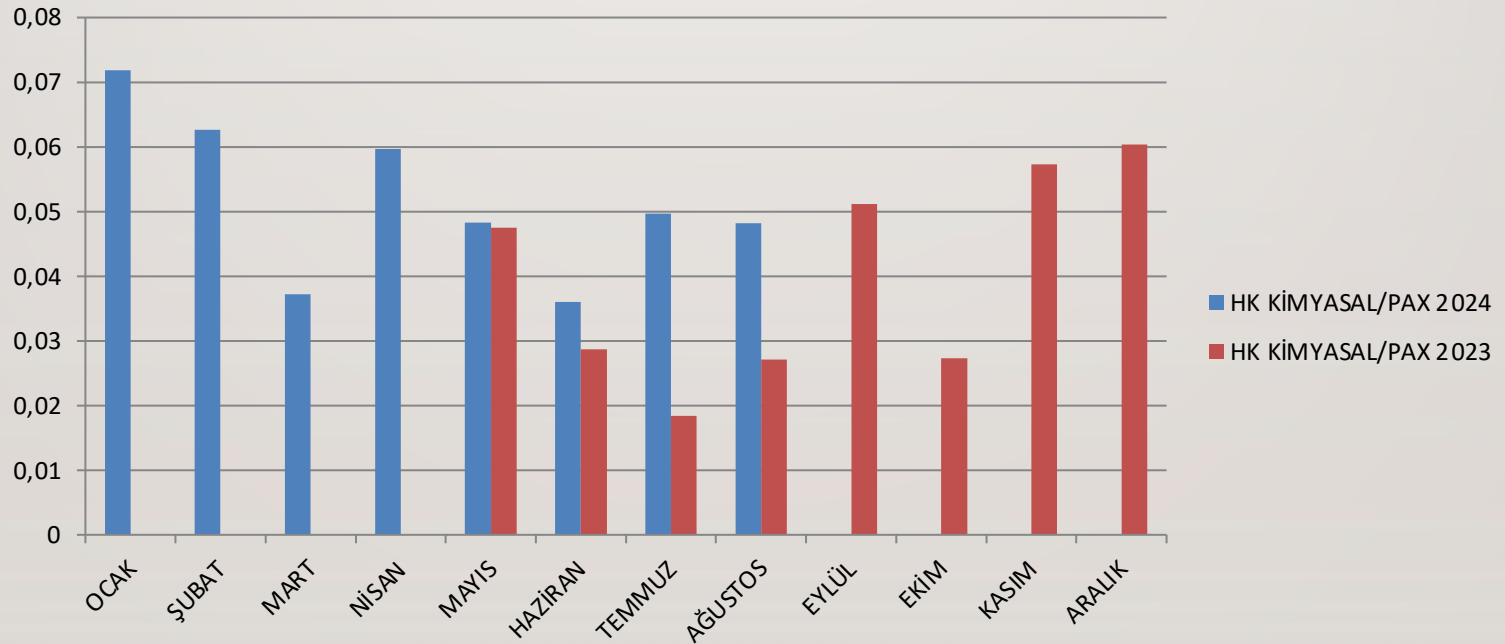
TECHNICAL SERVICE CHLORINE CONSUMPTION

TECHNICAL CHLORINE MONTHLY COMPARISON



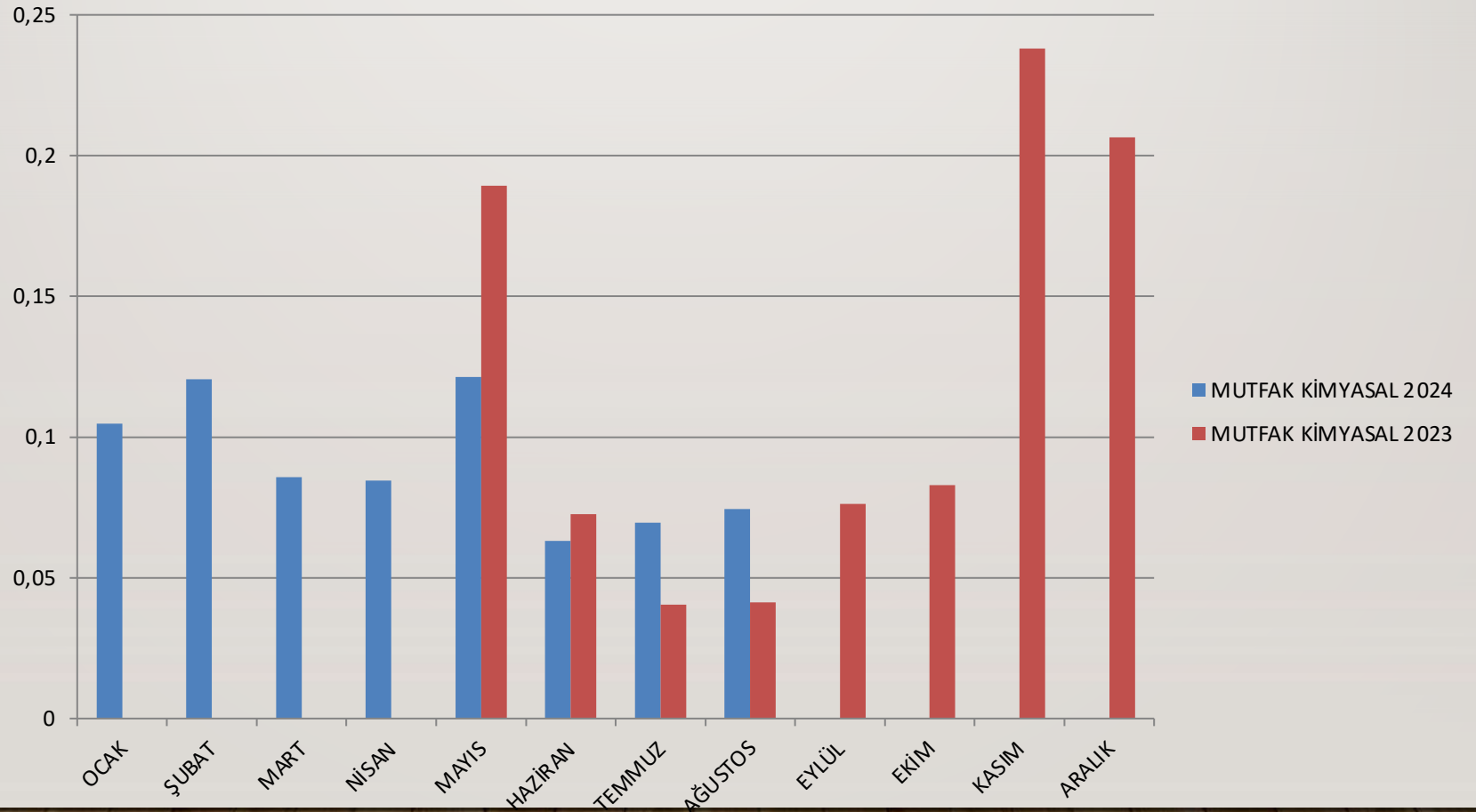
HOUSEKEEPING CHEMICAL CONSUMPTION

HK CHEMICAL MONTHLY COMPARISON



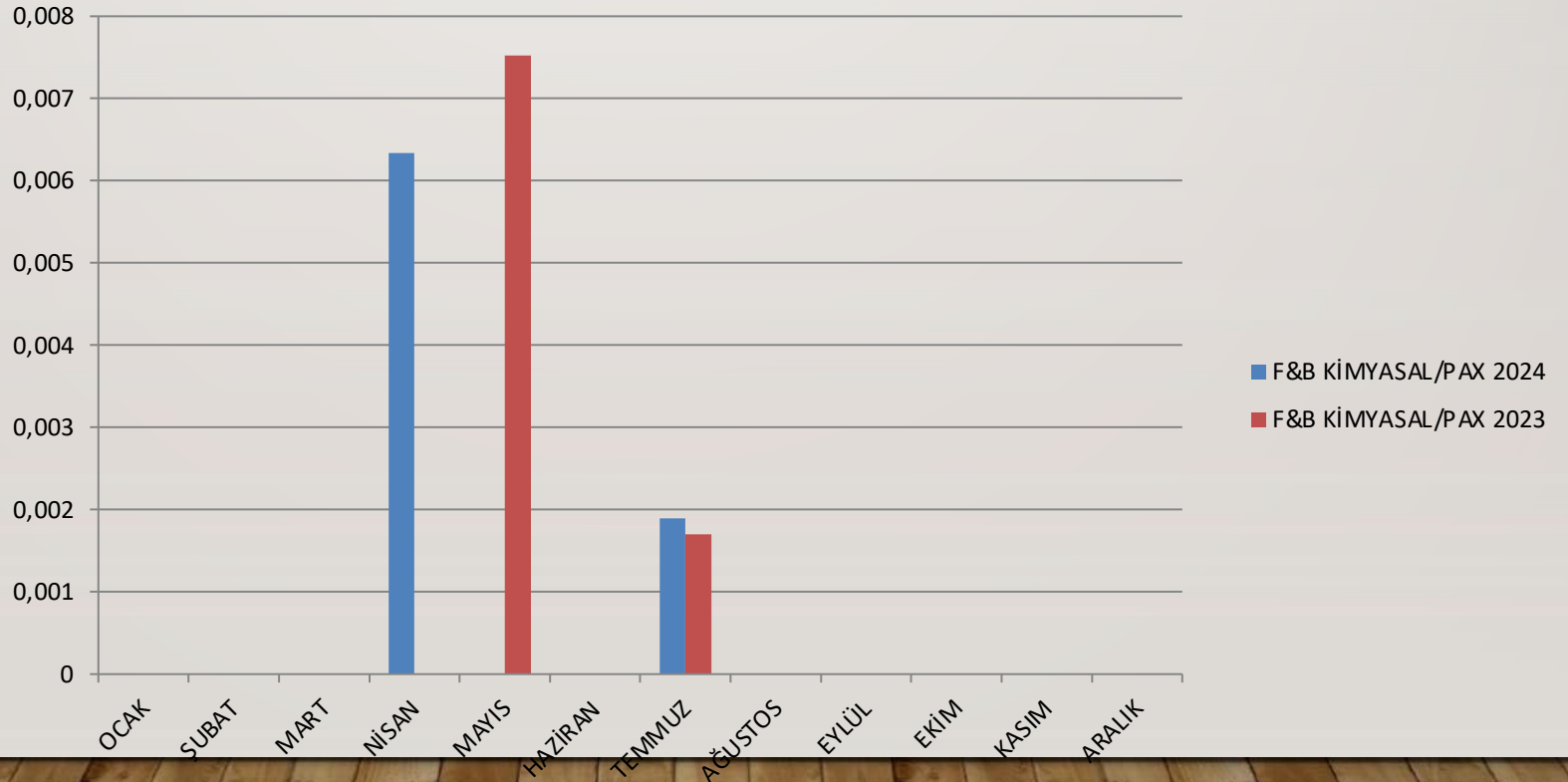

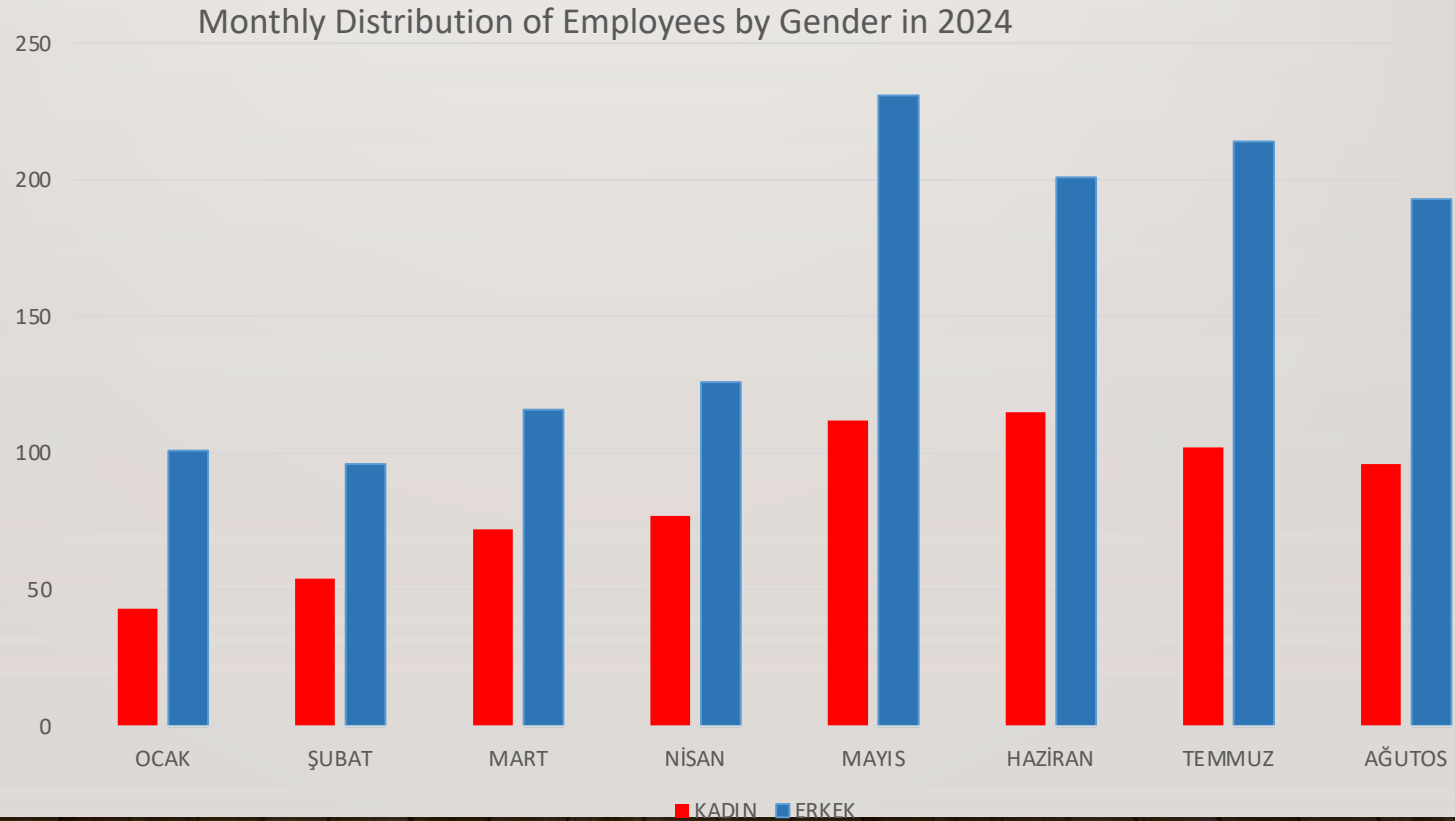

DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYEES BY NATIONALITY IN 2023

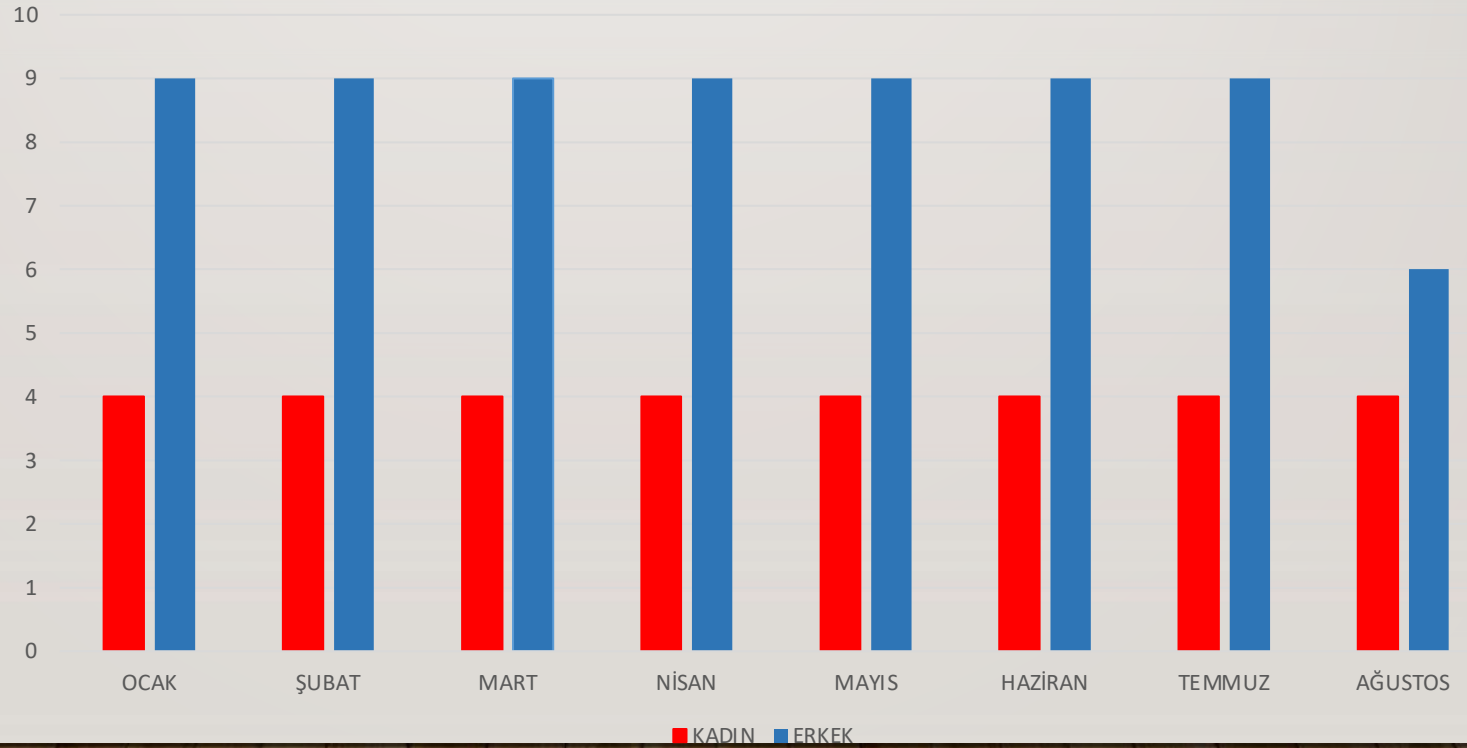


Monthly Distribution of Employees by Gender



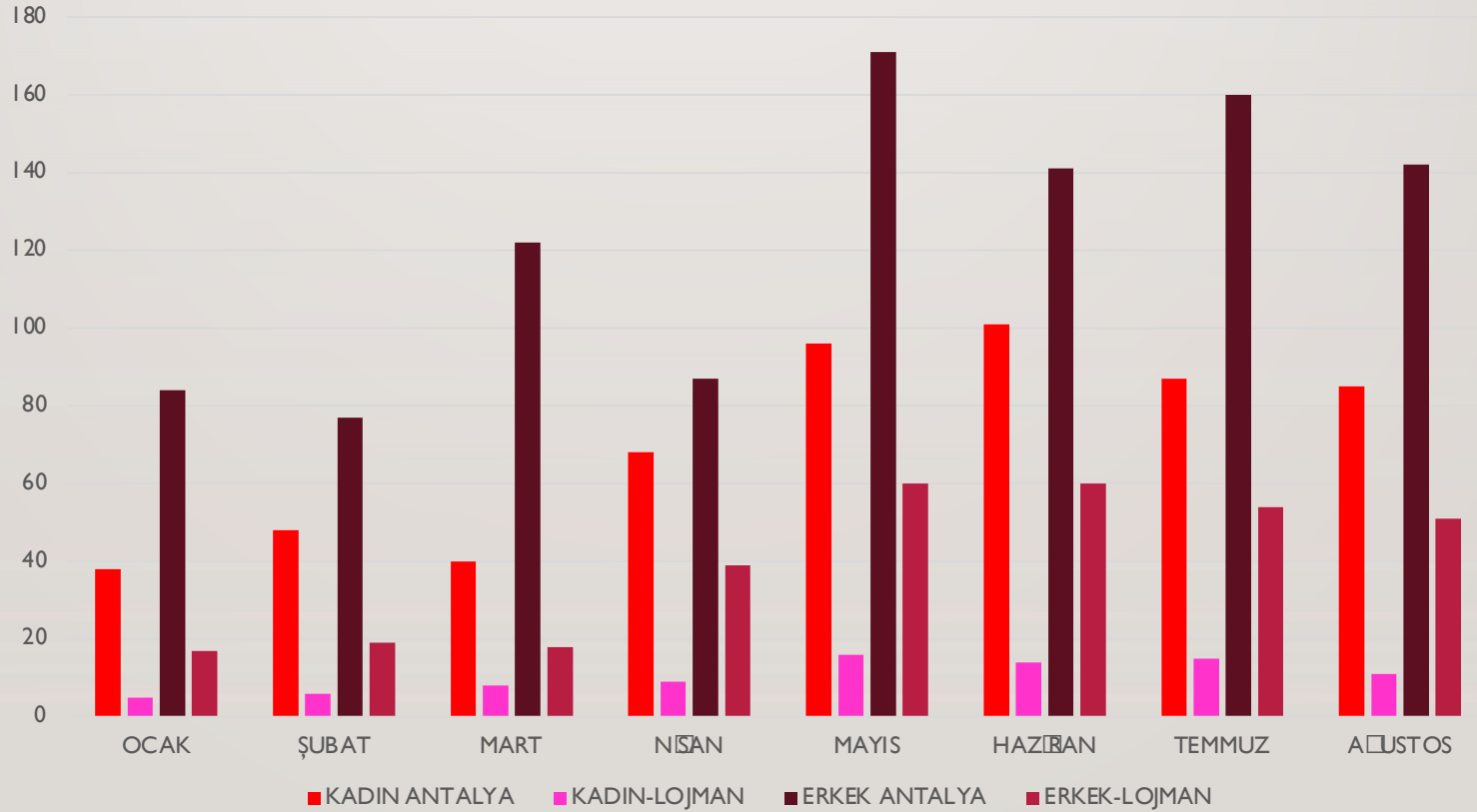
MONTHLY DISTRIBUTION OF MANAGERS BY GENDER

Monthly Breakdown



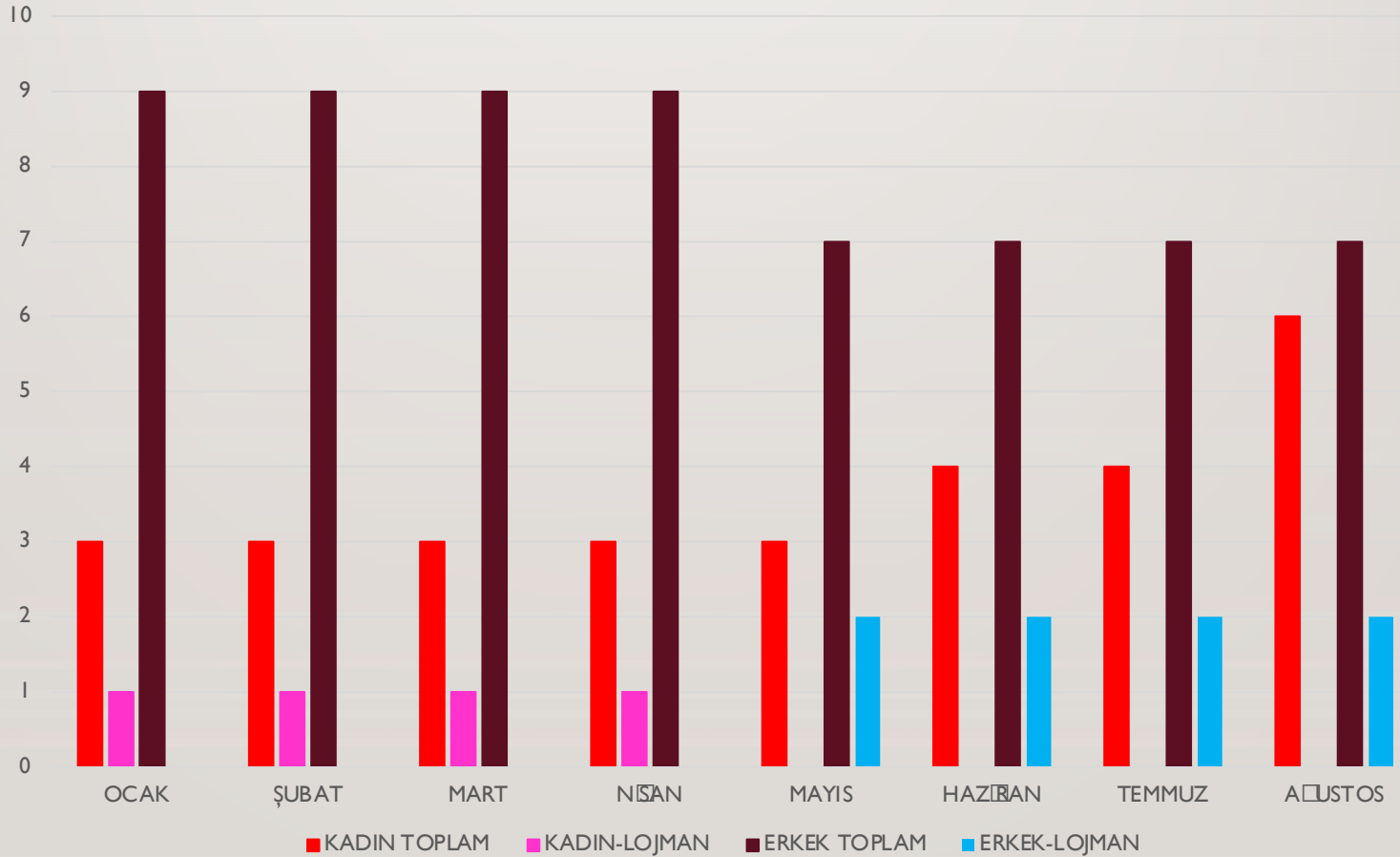
DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYEES BY RESIDENCE

Distribution of Employees by Residence



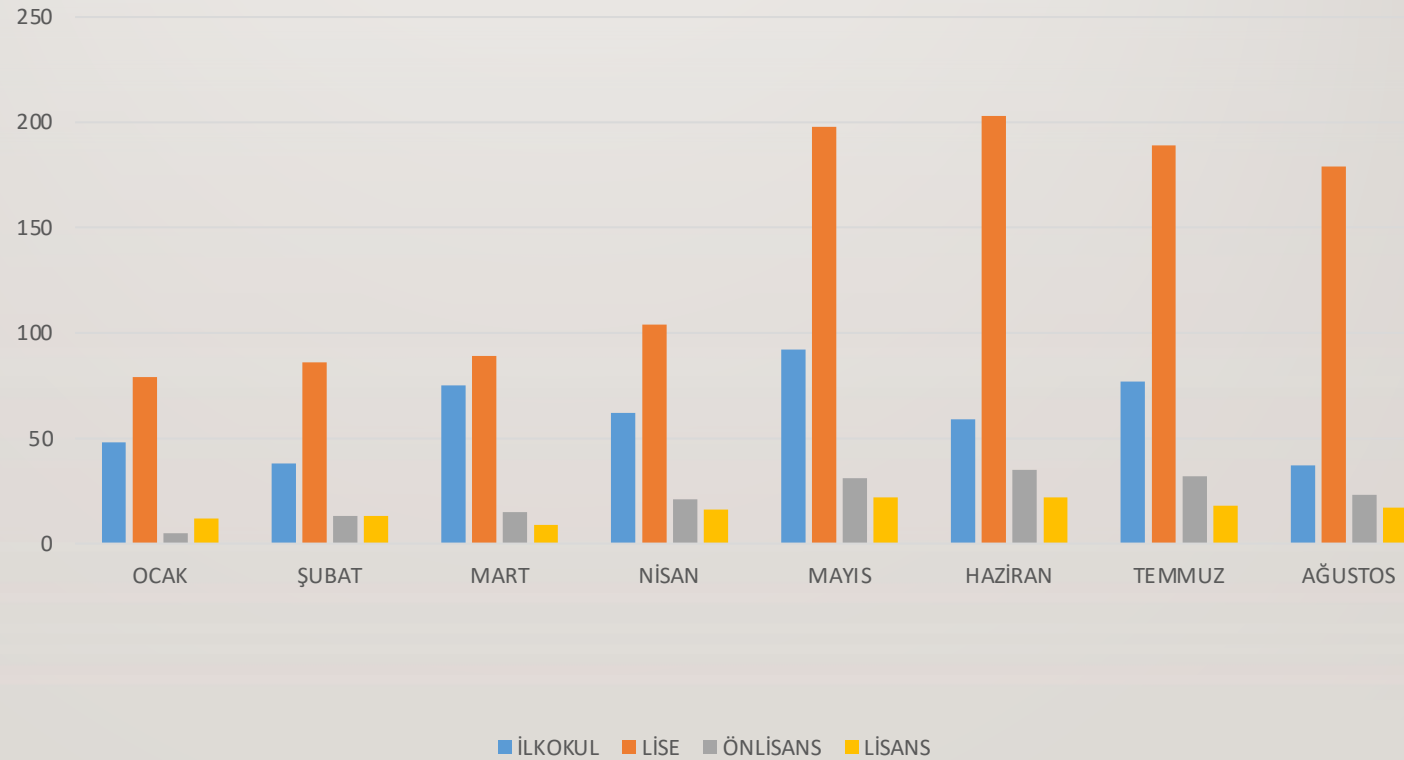
DISTRIBUTION OF MANAGERS BY RESIDENCE

Distribution of Managers by Residence



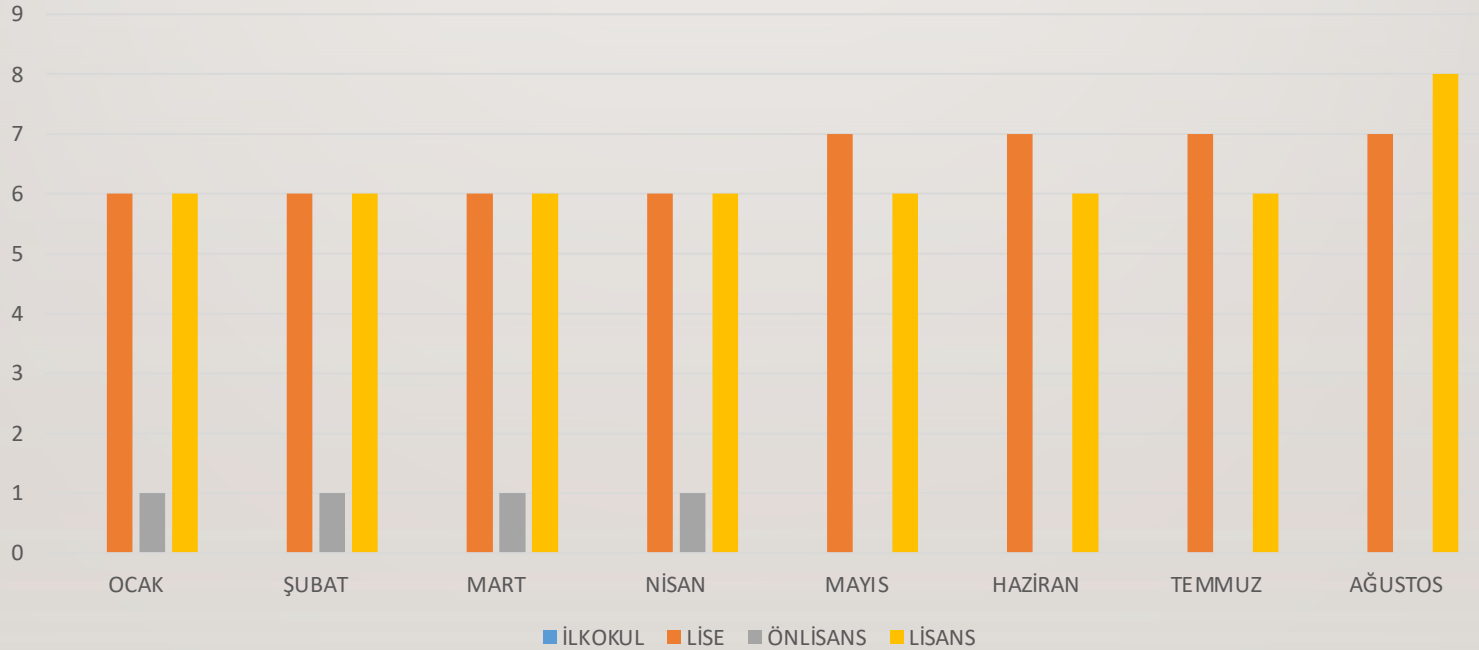
DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYEES BY EDUCATIONAL STATUS

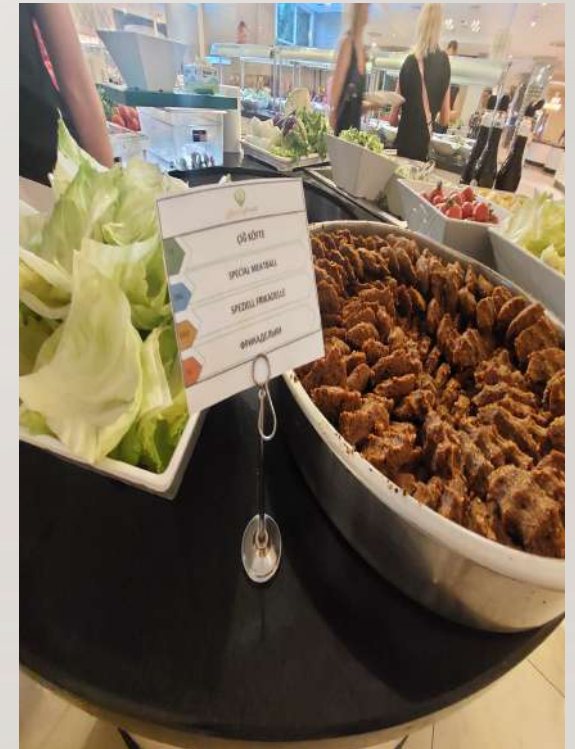

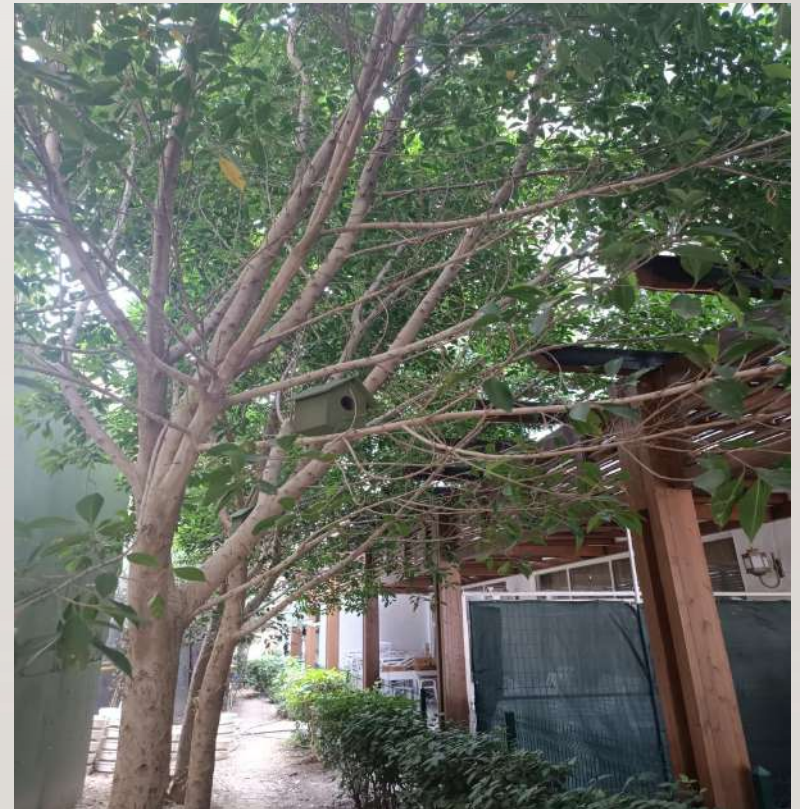
